Concepts: Form, Movement, Rhythm

Objectives:

- I can sing an echo.
- I can sing and move to music.
- I can clap and say rhythms.

Songs/Activities:

- Sing, "Welcome Welcome"
- Read the story, "All are Welcome Here"
- echo vegetable rhythms
- learn to sing "Wash Your Hands"
- make a picture showing what you'd like to do in music class this year.
- #174 "She'll Be Comin' Round The Mountain" - learn the song
- #6 "The Music Time is Over" - learn the goodbye song

Teaching Procedure

Activity #1: Sing "Welcome Welcome"

Listen to the song.

Play the video again and sing along!



Activity #2: Listen to the story, "All Are Welcome"

Pause the video and sing the welcome song each time you hear the words, "All are welcome here."



Activity #3: Practice Rhythm with Vegetable Rhythms

Watch the video and say the Vegetable Rhythms and clap right after the teacher.

You'll say the rhythms with the kids on the recording.



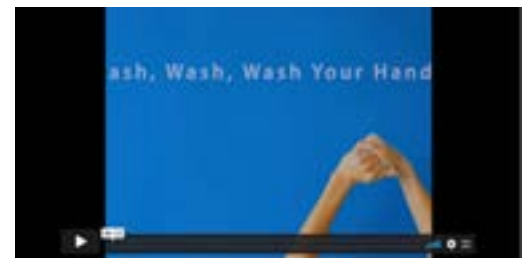
Activity #4: Sing the "Wash Your Hands" Song!
